## Greaseproof Paper Carrier Sheet By Maureen

Making a carrier sheet to print images from your printer is very easy to do. The cheap greaseproof available from Foodland is all that's required – no need to buy the expensive one.

- Cut a piece of greaseproof the size of an A4 sheet of paper (the roll is the same length as the page)
- Run a narrow strip of glue (a Blu gluestick is best) across the top of the paper and then attach the greaseproof, making sure to line it up with the edges of the A4 sheet.

Your carrier sheet is now ready to run through the printer – be sure you know which way to feed it into the printer

Once your image is printed out cut around leaving about a <sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" border and use the glue stick to glue the greaseproof onto the shell. Smooth out any creases that occur using your thumbnail or the back of a spoon etc.
