FANTASIA

A double yolk goose egg was used in original design, however the pattern is adjusted for a smaller goose egg.

Marking egg.

1. Divide egg into thirds. Draw a circle around the egg approximately 1½ inch from center bottom to give you a line

for aligning all three doors.

2. Trace pattern onto tissue paper. Darken the lines on back side and lay on the egg and trace. Position pattern on line. Do the same pattern on each line giving you three doors. After you have traced all three doors use a permanent marking pen and mark the entire design. Wash the egg clean of all pencil marks.

Cutting & hinging.

1. Cut where the hinges are going to be glued. Shape hinge so it will lay nice and flat on eggshell and loosen if the hinge is too tight. Sand the shiny finish off the hinge on the side that will be glued to the eggshell. Epoxy all three hinges in place.

2. Cut open all three doors. Clean the membrane from the inside of doors so they are nice and smooth. Clean any loose

membrane from inside the main body of shell. Let dry.

Painting.

1. The inside of main body of shell will have pearl flakes. Spread white glue all over inside and pour in pearl flakes. Pat down with fingers and dump out excess. Let dry and then brush on a coat of Mod Podge to seal the pearl flakes.

2. Paint the main body of shell a pale yellow on the outside.

3. Paint the fan on the doors white. Paint the bow and the treamers two shades of yellow so it looks like the front side and back side of a ribbon. After the paint is dry seal with a spray matte sealer.

Decorating.

1. Starting on the doors glue a row of gold cord around the edge of the rim. Next to that glue a row of rhinestone chain and then another row of gold cord. This should completely cover the rim but if it doesn't add another row of the gold cord.

2. Fan & Bow

A. Glue the gold lame around outside edge of fan.

B. Glue the gold thread on each spoke of the fan.

- C. Glue the gold lame on each scallop below where the little cutouts will be. (Refer to Fig. 1)
- D. Glue the little heart findings on the next scallops
- E. Glue four little flowers at bottom section of fan.

F. Glue lame around all the bow and streamers.

- H. Refer to Fig. 1 often as to the exact decorating of these little fans.
- 3. The sections in the fans will now be cut out and also the cutting around the bow and the streamers will be done at this time. Be careful as you are cutting on a door that is already cut open so you can't put alot of

Refer to Fig. 2 and the x's show you where to cut out.

4. Now that you have all the cutting done paint the inside of the doors the same as you did on the outside.

5. Decorate the rim with a row of gold cord, a row of pearls on the string and then another row of gold cord. The fans and bow and streamers will be done the same as the outside.

6. Glue ss5 flatback rhinestones to the bow and the streamers. Use Jonquil on the light parts and Topaz on the darker parts. Refer to Fig. 3 for an idea as to which parts to do dark and which to do light.

7. The fan will have a row of no hole pearls along the scalloped edge and also the section between the little flowers and the small heart findings will be completely filled in with the no hole pearls.

8. Glue a rhinestone to the center of each little flower.

9. Around each door on the main body of eggshell glue a row of gold cord on the edge followed by a row of pearls on the string and ending with a row of picot braid.

Glue the finished egg to base. Glue in figure of your choice. Assemble the top finial parts and epoxy to top of the finished egg. Assemble door pulls and glue to each door as shown on Fig. 4.
